Report on Howrah School

December – 2007

The attendance of students were satisfactory. Their progress in studies was also encouraging. They are learning the English alphabet and also memorizing numerical tables. They have started doing sums. In Bengali, they are learning Bengali words.

January – 2008

The children who are taught by the “Bridge System” have learnt to make words and form sentences with vowel signs. Many of them are now able to take dictations in Bengali. In English, they are learning to write words in small and capital letters. They can tell rhymes and spell words. In Arithmetic, they can do addition and subtraction sums and some of them can even do multi placion. They memorized multiplication tables mainly up to 4 with some children going up to 8 and 9.

Republic day celebration were held in the school on the 26th January, 2008. and children and their parents actively participated in the flag hoisting and other ceremonies.

February, 2008

There has been an all round improvement of the children. They are now able to form words and sentences easily and take dictations freely. They can count numbers upto 20 in English and write all the English alphabet in small and big hands.

The Annual Sports of the Howrah school was held on 25th February, 2008. All the students of the school except the sick ones participated. The parents of the children were present in large numbers. All the participants were given prizes and felicitated with snacks. It was a very successful and enjoyable event.

Report on Bhangar School

December - 2007

We are teaching the children through the new method learnt by us in our Training Classes. The children are identified with their names through name cards. Then they are taught about the common objects. They are also taught the English alphabet (A to Z) through rhymes. Lessons are given to them through stories and games. In addition to this, they are being taught to draw pictures and paint. The children have also to undergo "PT" Exercises and "Bratachari" dances.

January - 2008

The children of 3-4 years were first given oral lessons and taught poems. Others were taught through pictures and games.

Republic day was held on the 26th January 2008 with flag hoisting and other ceremonies.

February- 2008

The children were taught Bengali and English Alphabets and words. Then they were taught to form sentences from these words. They are also learning to draw pictures and memorizing rhymes. They have started learning numerical in Arithmetic. They do P.T. Exercises and are given lessons on health hygiene.

The Annual Sports of the School was held on the 6th February 2008 with great success. The children were very happy to participate in different events. Their parents and local people were also very much enthusiastic and helpful.
