A lot of improvement and progress in the ongoing “<b>Education and Health for Underprivileged Children</b> “has been achieved. Parents have become much more responsible and co-operative regarding the education and health of their children due to our monthly interactive Focus Group Discussion (FGD) and “Sensitization of Parents” sessions. We regularly discuss various aspects and benefits of proper education and good health. Regular medical check-ups of the children by experienced doctors and also treatment within the support of the government and Community Development Medicinal Unit is a set routine. The parents and their children are now so interested that they travel a long distances from their houses to attend school in the village (as in Bhangar) and suburban areas (as in Howrah). Near total eradication of school dropouts has been achieved through special support sessions and coaching classes.</p>

## **Report on Howrah Schools**

### **June 2008**

Attendance has been a bit low due to heavy monsoons. The students have started learning alphabets.

A 'Sit and Draw' competition was held on the 26<sup>th</sup> June' 08. Nearby all the students participated with great enthusiasm and their parents were very happy.

### **July 2008**

Attendance has greatly improved. The students have learnt to read and write both English and Bengali alphabets. In Arithmetic most of the children can write up to 20, some of them even 30. They can answer oral questions and have started learning numerical tables.

### **August 2008**

The children are now able to form words and even make short sentences in English and Bengali and tell rhymes. In Arithmetic, they have learns multiplication tables up to 3 and are also able to write down the spelling of figures up to 10.

## **Report on Bhangar School**

### **June 2008**

The new children of the school were totally illiterate. We started teaching them rhymes and then alphabets in Bengali and English. They were also taught names of animals, different limbs of the body etc. They were also given lessons in drawing and PT exercise.

### **July 2008**

The children were taught more rhymes, name of limbs in English and Bengali. Names of different objects were taught to them through picture. They were also taught to develop hygienic habits.

### **August 2008**

The children were taught to draw circles and lines on slates. The older children (4 and above) were taught to write words and numericals. In Bengali and English new words were taught to them.

A coaching class has also been started after the school hours (from 3.30 p.m.)
